A welcome new addition to Istanbul's roster of hotels, Ansen 130 is a boutique hotel located in the Tünel area, and offers historic architectural elegance with a touch of modern comfort. This small hotel, consisting of just ten suites, is located just a stone's throw from the city's best restaurants and bars. If you are fortunate enough to have secured a suite on one of the top floors (try to get suite 501), your private view is the breathtaking sunset over the Golden Horn.

The name Ansen 130 derives from a combination of the 150-year-old apartment building's original name (Ansen was the surname of the family that owned the building) and its street number. The old signboard has been kept in memory of its past owners and now adorns the wall behind the bar. Sympathetically converted by Yılmaz Değer, also the architect behind the building project for the country's leading GSM company, the historic façade has been retained. Conference facilities are fully-equipped with dataports and Internet access, and catering for up to eighty people is provided by ProLonge.

Ansen 130 is not the kind of hotel that intimidates visitors with an austere and formal lobby. Upon entrance, guests immediately find themselves in the middle of a chic café-bar surrounded by wood-panelled walls and local barflies. Just a few steps more brings travellers to Restaurant 130, which offers seating for thirty and cuisine which the hotel calls a 'fusion of New World and Mediterranean cuisine' under the guidance of renowned chef Mike Norman. Ansen Wine House next door provides cigars along with international vintages.
